Today's gospel about the Transfiguration always makes me think about the reaction of the disciples. Peter, James and John, the special friends of Jesus, go up the mountain with him and have the experience of seeing Jesus appear in white shining garments standing with Moses and Elijah. Peter says, "It is good for us to be here." I always felt I would be pretty blown away at this point. But it is not until the Father's voice is heard, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him," that the apostles are terrified and fall flat on the ground.

Then comes the second quote I love: "Do not be afraid." The apostles look up and only Jesus is there.

It's good for me to be here and no matter what happens, including the inevitable unexpected, I won't be afraid. Easier to say than do sometimes...
